Essay #2 (Tiebreaker essay)	5
Personal Statement	4
Involvement in church (Provide documentation for last 4 years)	5
Involvement in district (Provide documentation for last 4 years)	4
Involvement in school (Provide documentation for last 4 years)	4
Involvement in community (Provide documentation for last 4 years)	4
Leadership roles (Provide documentation for last 4 years)	3
Member of district church	3
University/community college/trade school acceptance letter(s)	1
